This is certainly one of Zinfandels that are among the most interesting I have tasted in 15 years. Developed by Peter Franus, this Zinfandel is distinguished by its elegance and balance in spite of his generosity and opulence. In 1987, after studies in viticulture and oenology, Peter Franus founded his company. It offers us here a delicious wine that reflects the unique character of the mountainous vineyards of Mount Veeder from which it is grown Zin. No heaviness, unlike many Zin, in this expressive wine that releases aromas reminiscent of raspberries, cherries, cranberries, plums and rose petals, accented with spicy notes, empyreumatic and slightly smoky. The texture is velvety, acidity precisely metered, well-integrated tannins, and all quite harmonious concludes with a long finish! (Google translation from the French)
